**Funded Programs**

**HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES**

**Increasing Access to Oral Health Services: (\$34,541).** A project of CommuniCare Health Centers. Funding to provide dental screenings, exams, dental services including fluoride varnish, and dental education dental services to 450 low-income children at five Head Start sites throughout the County and RISE, Inc. early childhood program, in order to increase preschoolers' access to dental services.

**Health Insurance Outreach, Enrollment, Utilization and Retention: (\$162,712)** A Yolo County Children's Alliance project. Funded for health insurance outreach, enrollment, utilization and retention services for uninsured children 0-5 years old. 8

**Baby Friendly Formula Free Gift Bags: (\$33,000).** Woodland Memorial Hospital received funding to distribute non-formula branded gift bags to delivering moms in support of their baby friendly policies promoting breastfeeding.

**Healthy Kids Insurance Premiums: (\$102,906)** Funding provided to Partnership HealthPlan of California to administer First 5 Yolo's Healthy Kids Insurance Program and provide medical, dental, vision and behavioral health coverage to children ages 0-5.

**SCHOOL READINESS**

**West Sacramento School Readiness: (\$174,972)** A Washington Unified School District program. Funded to provide school readiness direct services and referrals for children 0-5 years old in the communities in the catchment areas of Elkhorn, Evergreen and Westfield Elementary Schools of West Sacramento.

**Woodland School Readiness: (\$181,068)** A Woodland Joint Unified School District program. Funded to provide school readiness direct services and referrals for children 0-5 years old in the community in the catchment area for Prairie School.

**Head Start Universal Preschool for West Sacramento Spaces (\$25,000)** A collaborative project of the Yolo County Office of Education. Funding provided for the enrollment of children into Universal Preschool for West Sacramento program and also to promote preschool teacher workforce development.

**Universal Preschool for West Sacramento: (\$492,721)** A project of the City of Davis Resource and Referral Agency. Funded to recruit, support and monitor contracts with private childcare centers and family childcare homes participating in the Universal Preschool for West Sacramento program.

**EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION**

**Special Projects Triad: (\$20,023).** A project of RISE, Inc. Funding supports a transition to Kindergarten project, extended learning centers, and emotional support programs for mothers of infants.

**Family Reading Programs: (\$29,800).** A project of the Winters Friends of the Library aimed to enhance reading and learning readiness by providing reading experiences, age-appropriate books, and parent education, literacy, and support.

**Retention Incentive Opportunity: (\$298,249)** A City of Davis Resource and Referral Agency program. Funded to provide for the implementation of the Child Care Retention Incentives Program, which provides childcare stipends for childcare quality enhancement.

**Universal Early Learning: (\$158,496)** A project of RISE, Inc. Funding provides for an array of capacity building and support services for childcare and early education services in the Esparto/Capay Valley Region.

**Yolo County Child Care Collaborative: (\$383,186)** A City of Davis Childcare Resource and Referral project. Funding provides for an array of capacity building and support services for childcare and early education services countywide.

#### PARENT & FAMILY SUPPORT

**Parenting Classes & Breastfeeding Consultation: (\$33,000).** A project of CommuniCare Health Centers. Funding to provide lessons in positive parenting concepts and practices and breastfeeding consultations and interventions to increase breastfeeding rates.

**Foster Parent Recruitment & Retention Program: (\$33,000).** A project of the Foster & Kinship Care Education Program. Funding provides for outreach and education regarding the need for additional Yolo County foster families accepting placement of children 0 – 5 and recruitment and certification of new foster family homes. 8

**Keep Our Kids Local- Childcare Subsidy Program: (\$33,000).** Yolo County DESS Child Welfare Services provides childcare subsidies to licensed Yolo County foster parents accepting placement of children 0 – 5 to positively affect the number local placements for this age group.

**Media-Based Parent/Child Education & Visitation Project: (\$33,000).** A project of the Yolo County Probation Department. Funding provided media-based parenting classes to incarcerated and released minors with young children to teach effective parenting skills while strengthening the bond between parent and child therefore improving outcomes for this at-risk group of young children.

**PCIT at Cache Creek Continuation School: (\$13,946).** Yolo Family Services Agency received grant funding to provide Parent-Child Interaction Therapy to teenage parents of Cache Creek Continuation High School and their children to encourage positive parenting, improved child behavior and reductions in parental stress.

#### SYSTEMS CHANGE

**Federally Qualified Health Clinic Consultant for CommuniCare Pediatric Dental Services Expansion: (\$10,000).** A project of CommuniCare Health Centers. Funding provided to hire a FQHC Dental Consultant to provide technical assistance to CommuniCare Health Centers to develop a business plan to expand the capacity of their dental clinics for pediatric care. The business plan would include strategies to improve the payor mix and quality improvement.

**Universal Application System (COMPASS): (\$50,000).** A project of Vistalogic, Inc. to develop and implement a countywide universal application system to screen families for a variety of public services including health insurance programs.
