- I. Call to Order/Welcome/Public Comment  
*Chair Provenza called the meeting to order at 9:49AM. No public comment.*
  
- II. COVID-19 Emergency Response Update  
*G. Daleiden briefed the Executive Committee on emergency response efforts to procure and distribute needed supplies to childcare providers and children and families. The childcare supply work is being done in partnership with the Yolo County Office of Education, Local Childcare Planning Council leadership, and Children's Home Society. Efforts to support children and families are being coordinated, as appropriate, with Yolo Food Bank and County of Yolo Emergency Operations Center contact, Deputy CAO Jill Cook.*

*G. Daleiden also discussed the COVID-19 resource page on First 5 Yolo's website and social media, as well as approvals of emergency funding for partners per First 5 Yolo's Resolution 2020-01.*

*Executive Committee expressed approval of the direction and beginning results.*

III. First 5 Yolo Contracts and Changes During Shelter Orders

*G. Daleiden briefed the Executive Committee on planning for two expected grant programs from First 5 CA, IMPACT 2020 and Home Visiting Coordination. Both grants will require flexibility in, and likely changes to, proposed implementation due to COVID-19 and Shelter Orders. This may require temporary SOWs in contracts associated with the grants, much as First 5 Yolo has done with current contracts. Two salaried, part-time staff will be hired and both will be funded by the grants.*

*Executive Committee expressed an interest in hiring the IMPACT staff as soon as possible to help relieve the current burden on existing staff.*

*G. Daleiden also highlighted some of the quick work by current funded partners to change method of service deliver in compliance with COVID precautions.*

IV. Childhood Immunization Rates and Well-Baby/Child Medical Visits During COVID-19

*H. Kellison expressed a strong interest in assuring that First 5 helps to promote the message that parents should contact their child's doctor to inquire about staying current on immunizations and well-child visits, particularly as immunizations rates appear to be falling during the pandemic. J. Provenza and S. Brown concurred. G. Daleiden agreed to speak with First 5 CA Executive Director about the role First 5 CA might play in a public awareness campaign.*
