



### HOW MUCH DID WE DO?

Despite disruptions brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic, First 5 Yolo served **5,007 participants** countywide



First 5 Yolo continued increasing services for prenatal-age 3, a critical time for early support  
**48% of children served were under 2 years old**



### Our Mission

First 5 Yolo will assist our community in raising children who are **healthy, safe, and ready to learn**. We will ensure that our resources are effectively used, and all community voices are heard.

### What We Do

First 5 engages community partners to design, improve, advocate for, and fund critical services to support the needs of children and their families prenatally through age five by administering Proposition 10 (tobacco tax) and other funds.

**First 5 helps build a coordinated system of care to achieve more equitable outcomes for young children and their families.**



**13,000 Cases** of PPE and essential supplies distributed

# HOW WELL DID WE DO IT? & IS ANYONE BETTER OFF?

## First 5 Yolo and Funded Partners focused on keeping children healthy, safe and connected

The following indicators represent the work from First 5 Funded Partners in Road to Resilience initiative (R2R) and the Yolo Crisis Nursery.



**85%** of children were up to date on immunizations



**99%** of families avoided the need for entry or re-entry into Child Welfare Services



**100%** of parents felt more socially connected



**403** emergency childcare slots gave respite to families

## First 5 Yolo Initiatives



**The CHILD Project: Road To Resilience** (R2R) is a coordinated system of evidence-informed home visiting and family navigation services to help connect families experiencing adversity during pregnancy and early infancy to needed health and social services and to provide children the best start in life.



**88%** of children enrolled in R2R home visiting received their last recommended well-child visit



**100%** of clients reported their home visitor worked with them on what mattered most to them



**IMPACT2020** provides county-wide coordination to support an integrated Yolo Quality Counts California system including coaching coordination, county-wide trainings, and compliance with county and state QCC guidelines to improve the quality of early learning.



**91%** Family, Friend, Neighbor (FFN) Providers completed a Training Series



**2,432** Activity Kits Distributed



**9** FFN providers working towards licensure




**92%** of FFN Providers achieved at least 1 Goal



**Help Me Grow** is a universal care-coordination system linking health and education systems for improved early identification, prevention and treatment of developmental, behavioral and psychosocial risks, so all children have the supports they need, when they need them and reach their optimal development.

**868** Developmental screens completed



**253** Developmental Playgroups were offered to the community (~105% increase from FY19-20)

**15** Infant Mental Health Specialists Trained

### Whole Child Whole Family



**100%** of caregivers reported increased knowledge of appropriate activities to facilitate their child's development



**100%** of caregivers reduced depression scores and improved functioning in daily activities

# Systems Change: It's All About Relationships!

First 5 Yolo's three main initiatives (R2R, IMPACT 2020, and Help Me Grow) and other Funded Partners, address our four Strategic Priority Areas, all of which work together to support healthy children, ready to reach their optimal development.

## Strategic Priority Areas (Supported by three main initiatives)



### Improve Systems & Networks

Support and enhance a system of care that is coordinated, responsive, and delivered by effective providers.



### Improve Child Safety

Support and strengthen parents, caregivers, and families to provide safe environments and relationships to allow children 0-5 to thrive.




### Improve Child Health

Provide prevention and early intervention so that children prenatal through 5 are supported in reaching their optimal developmental outcomes.



### Improve Quality Early learning

Improve access and opportunity for quality early learning so that children enter kindergarten ready to learn.
